Food and Drink

- School meals

The School Charter

- Rewards/Sanctions we use positive praise rewarding children with stickers, merits and certificates, however at times we may need to use sanctions to ensure children are safe and happy. Please ask in the office if you wish to read our school behaviour policy for more information on this
- If any rules from our School Charter are broken the children get a look. Then they are issued with a warning. If the behaviour continues the children receive an orange card. If behaviour stops the orange card can be removed. If behaviour continues they receive a red card and have 2-5 minutes time out depending on age of child.



- Phonics taught daily

- Recording when you have heard your child read please record in the reading record every time you hear your child read, this helps us to know how they are doing as it isn't possible for us to hear children read every day

Home learning

- YR Daily reading at home and phonics practice.
- Y1 A topic grid with English/maths/theme activities will be sent home at the beginning of each term and home learning books should be returned on a fortnightly basis.
- Home learning also includes; daily reading and weekly class spellings.
